

Villa Heights Baptist Youth Guidelines

Most of these guidelines are just common sense and should not be a problem.

1. When having a group devotion or session, **Do Not** distract the person speaking or talk with others during this time. You will be given the opportunity to share or ask questions.
2. When the schedule requires you to be in your room, **Be There** unless special arrangements are made with youth leader.
3. No one is allowed to leave the designated area without contacting a leader.
4. All youth are required to be present and on time at all meals, devotions, group and recreation sessions when on a trip. If you are late, you are making the whole group wait for you. Any exceptions must be approved by a leader.
5. No smoking, drugs, alcohol, or **ANY** typed of tobacco products will be tolerated at any youth activity by students or adults. Inappropriate language or talking about others will not be tolerated.
6. In case of an emergency, contact a chaperone as soon as possible.
7. If you need any ordinary medicine, (aspirin, band-aids, feminine products, etc.) please see a youth leader. **Please** make sure a leader is aware of any special medicine needs you may have.
8. No walkman's, Game Boys, MP'3s or other electronic "fellowship busters", water guns, knives, fireworks, or cigarette lighters, unless they are part of the activity. If you have them they will be confiscated until the activity is over.
9. Dress appropriate! No short shorts, no 2 piece swim suits for girls or Speedo's for guys. No offensive T-shirts, no spaghetti straps on tank tops. Dress should always reflect Christ-like character and attitude.
10. Girls will not be allowed in guy's rooms or guys in girl's rooms. Leaders will give instructions if one of these rooms is to be used as a group meeting room.
11. Under no circumstances are guys and girls allowed under same blankets, sleeping bags, or any other covering (i.e. coats, or other apparel) together. No "PDA's" (public displays of affection) between boyfriends and girlfriends whether part of our youth group or belonging to another.
12. Youth are not allowed to drive on any church related activity unless special arrangements are made ahead of time.

** These guidelines are here for a purpose. Breaking them will have consequences which will be determined by a panel of youth and adults.

** I have read and understand these guidelines. I will also seek to set an example by adhering to them at all times.
